Scheduled Maintenance - Pipeline Internal Monitoring

As part of its ongoing integrity management program, Iroquois will be performing an internal inspection of its Eastchester line. The inspection is scheduled to take place the week of April 21 and will involve activity at Iroquois' facilities located on Eaton's Neck Road in Northport, NY and at Hunts Point in the Bronx.

A computerized device, or smart tool, will be inserted into the pipeline at the Northport facility and will then be pushed through the pipe at a controlled speed by the pressure of natural gas. Iroquois will extract the tool at its Hunts Point facility in the Bronx. This activity will occur twice as a pre-run is necessary to assure cleanliness and passage of the smart tool.

The process of insertion and extraction of the device(s) requires depressurization of the launcher and/or receiver barrels. During this process, a Zero Emission Vacuum and Compressor (ZEVAC) system will be used to draw down the pressurized gas and transfer it into our mainline, resulting in only a very small amount of natural gas being released to the atmosphere. Work activities will take place throughout the day.

The data collected from the smart tool provides Iroquois valuable information concerning the integrity of our pipeline, thereby continuing our commitment to our neighbors and customers to deliver natural gas safely and reliably.

The following schedule provides the locations and approximate times for the insertion and extraction of the devices.
